## PAC (Parent Activity Committee) News

The annual **AVON Fundraiser** made \$3,349.02. There were 113 families and 5 staff that participated. Thank you for your support with this fundraiser!

If you need any ideas for staff holiday gift giving, the **Teacher Wish Lists** are now online on our website [www.freedompac.org](http://www.freedompac.org). They will also be available at the Holiday Gift Shop or in the PAC mailbox.

The **Cookie Dough Fundraiser** was the highest grossing fundraiser to date! Sales were approximately \$32,500 with profit at about \$16,250 for our students! Pick-up date for cookie dough is **December 9 from 3:00 - 5:30 in the multipurpose room**. If your child sold 3 or 5 items and didn't receive their Minion key chain or stuffed animal, they can do so during the cookie dough distribution.

**Paper Recycling Update.** We made \$479 with our paper collection. The next paper recycling is scheduled for **December 21<sup>st</sup> through January 4<sup>th</sup>**.

**Plastic Bag Recycling.** PAC is again participating in the plastic bag recycling through Trex. Our school will receive an item made from recycled plastic for participating in this program. Your child should have received a reminder magnet and sheet. Place clean bags into the bins by the front office from now until April 15<sup>th</sup>.

**Holiday Gift Shop.** PAC will hold a Holiday Gift Shop for the students to purchase gifts for family and friends. This event will be held in the elementary cafeteria **December 4<sup>th</sup> from 3:30-6pm** and **December 5<sup>th</sup> from 9am until noon**. High school volunteers will help children choose their gifts and stay within their budget. There will be gift bags provided for each gift purchased. A few days before the sale, we will send home an envelope for parents to write who the student should buy for and how much they should spend on each person. The children should bring the envelope with them to the Shop.
