

Dear Juniors and Junior Parents,

Freedom High School will offer an ACT Review Course for juniors during the week of Monday, February 2 – Thursday, February 5 from 3:30–4:30 p.m.

Course Details:

- Students will complete a practice ACT test on their own; materials and instructions will be shared with registered students.
- Each day, students rotate through subject-specific groups: Math, Science, Reading, English.
- No session on Friday, February 6
- Bring a water bottle; snacks will be provided.
- Students who must leave early for sporting events will be assigned make-up sessions.

Why it matters:

- ACT scores are used not only by universities but also by technical colleges **and trade/apprenticeship programs** in Wisconsin for admission and program placement.
- A strong ACT score can also help with scholarship opportunities and reduce additional placement testing.

Registration:

- Complete and detach the bottom portion of this letter and return it to the High School Counseling Office by Wednesday, January 28.
- Cost: \$50 (checks payable to FHS Testing)

This course is a valuable way for juniors to prepare for the ACT and improve scores for college, technical programs, or trades.
