- **2021** Untaxed Income Records, such as child support or veteran's non-education benefits
- Information on savings, investments, business assets and farm assets (if applicable)
- Cell phone (if you have one)
- Driver's License (if you have one)
- Social Security Number
- Alien Registration Card or Permanent Resident Card (if you are not a U.S.)
- Date of birth for parent(s)
- Month and year of parents' marriage, divorce or separation

If you are considered a DEPENDENT STUDENT (under the age of 24) for financial aid purposes, you will also need these items for your parent(s)

2024-2025 FAFSA

(Opens sometime after December 1st, 2023)

- **2022** Federal Tax Return and W2s
- **2022** Untaxed Income Records, such as child support or veteran's non-education benefits
- Information on savings, investments, business assets and farm assets (if applicable)
- Cell phone (if you have one)
- Driver's License (if you have one)
- Social Security Number
- Alien Registration Card or Permanent Resident Card (if you are not a U.S. citizen)
- Date of birth for parent(s)
- Month and year of parents' marriage, divorce or separation
