# Immunization Requirements 2018-2019

**Varicella** (Chickenpox) second dose phase

Grades Kindergarten through 12

**Measles, Mumps, Rubella** (MMR)

Grades Kindergarten through 12

**Tdap** (Diphtheria, Tetanus, and Pertussis Booster)

Entering Grade 6

There is an exception to the Tdap requirement: Students who received a dose of tetanus or diphtheria vaccine within **5 years** of entering a grade for which Tdap is required are not required to receive Tdap vaccine.

1. If your child has a medication that is kept at school, the medication must be picked up no later than June 14, 2018. All medication, prescription and/or over the counter will be disposed of after this date. **The medication must be picked up by an adult, NO medication will be sent home with students.**
2. Emergency plan paperwork for 2018-2019 school year will be mailed home at the end of May. Any child with asthma, allergies (not seasonal), diabetes, and/or seizure disorder must have a new plan completed at the start of school. If you do not receive a plan in the mail and your child should have one, please contact the health services team.
