

# School Requirements for Immunization: Sixth- | 2<sup>th</sup> grades



Vaccines are required for Wisconsin students.\* You can get a copy of the Student Immunization Record from your school or download a copy: <https://www.dhs.wisconsin.gov/forms/f0/F04020I.pdf>. At the start of the new school year, give the complete Student Immunization Record to the school.

## How do I complete the Student Immunization Record?



Call your doctor or local health department and make a **vaccine visit** by early summer.



Ask your doctor to **fill out** the Student Immunization Record and then you **sign** it.



**Give** the Student Immunization Record to the school at the beginning of the new school year.



Call your doctor's office or local health department if you **need help** or more information.
