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**Curriculum:**

Freedom High School offers student opportunities to work at an accelerated pace through Advanced Placement courses, Early College Credit, Start College Now, CAPP program, and Youth Apprenticeship opportunities.

**Graduation Requirements:**

As of the class of 2024, 28 credits are the minimum required for graduation, including:
